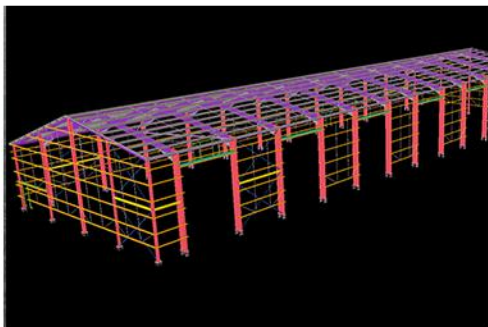
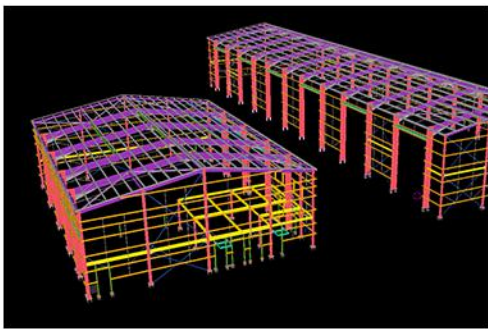

## Retail

Snashall steel were appointed to provide the drawing, fabrication and erection for the new MOT test centre and refuse building as part of the new £7.8 million depot expansion for the Aylesbury Vale district council.

The MOT test centre is a portal framed building along with a small internal mezzanine floor. It also features a number of large entrance doors to allow for easy access for the vehicles being tested. Along with two small galvanised entrance canopies to the main personnel doors which are thermally broken from the main frame. The building also features a large amount of cold rolled steel to allow for the fixing of the cladding. The refuge building is a 75m long portal frame building with 6 large entrance doors. Similar to the MOT centre the refuge building is also completely covered in cold rolled.
